This scholarship award is being offered in honor of the late Chief Gary R. Cline, Retired, Merchantville Police Department, to a graduating high school senior who will be pursuing a career in Law Enforcement.

Chief Cline joined the Merchantville Police Department in 1959 as a patrolman, attaining the rank of sergeant in 1974. He served as Chief from 1978 until his retirement in 1985. He was a member of the Camden County Police Chiefs Association and the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police.

During his career, he was appointed to the Board of the Camden County Hero Scholarship Fund.

Many individuals have served the Camden County Hero Scholarship over the years, but Chief Cline's dedication stands out. He not only served as a trustee since 1980, he held the position of Treasurer for nearly fifteen years. He was active on various committees, and we could always count on his help for the events and activities that we sponsored. And more than anything else, he was a good friend to many of us.

In appreciation for all of Chief Gary Cline's years of devoted service to the Camden County Hero Scholarship Fund, and to Law Enforcement, we proudly offer this scholarship in his name.



The amount of this scholarship for the 2024 year will be \$1,500.

Each application shall be considered on its merit and all scholarships and/or grants will be awarded at the sole discretion of the Board of Trustees. All decisions of the selection committee are final.

Funds must be utilized within 36 months of commencing first fall semester.

To Qualify

- The applicant's course of study must be related to the Law Enforcement Field.
- Student Status: The applicant must be a registered member of the graduating high school class of 2024.
- Diploma Requirements: The applicant must be eligible to receive his/her High school diploma prior to September 1, 2024.
- School Attendance: The applicant must be a registered student in any private, parochial or public school located in Camden County.
- Aspirations: The student must have a definite plan to pursue a post-high school program of education or training.
- Character: The applicant must have exhibited good citizenship traits and be of sound moral character.
- Post-High School Program: The applicant must plan on the pursuit of his or her post-high school program on a full-time basis.

Application Requirement Checklist

EACH ITEM BELOW MUST BE INCLUDED IN ORDER FOR APPLICATION TO BE CONSIDERED.

- □ You, the applicant, must arrange with your high school Guidance Counselor for the forwarding to Scholarship Committee of:
 - Your Secondary School transcript including SAT scores.
 - School's recommendation with a special notation relative to character and citizenship. Please limit to two (2) submissions.
- □ Fill in the attached application form (please type or print clearly).

□ Attach the application form to a plain piece of paper on which you supply the following information:

- 1) List the colleges or trade schools you have applied to (in order of preference) and their anticipated costs.
- 2) List the Extra Curricular and Community Activities in which you have participated in the order of importance to you. Include the activity, dates of participation, hours per week and the position you held.
- 3) List your work experience by giving the job, employer, dates and hours per week on the job. Also include any work you plan for next summer.
- 4) Give a brief statement of what aspect of law enforcement you wish to pursue, and why.
- 5) Write a brief statement of financial need, specifying why these scholarship funds would be a help to you.
- □ Be sure to fill in the entire application form and mail with the above requested information to:
